Position Summary

Our State projects are aimed at working with the Education Department on top-down, largescale, systemic reform projects with the goal of improving student learning outcomes. When we engage with a State, we conduct a thorough diagnostic exercise to identify and prioritize the critical interventions necessary for improving the quality of education. Our team supports the State on design and implementation of these interventions, while also strengthening governance and other key enablers that are critical for reform. These interventions can focus on academics and pedagogy, while also improving key enablers, improving the administration and governance structures, and making the Education system more accountable to outcomes and performance.

We have partnered with the Education Department of Gujarat on a long-term engagement for system reform and have set up a team in Gandhinagar.

The Team Lead would be based in Delhi and support the State team director in developing monitoring evaluation and learning frameworks for Gujarat and potential next states. S/he will work with experts in the field to vet the frameworks created, identify and manage partners for polishing and implementing the M&E plans for the projects. S/he will also be required to work with secondary and primary data that's being collected in the programs and analyse them. The role will report to the Senior Program Manager, State Reform.

Key responsibilities include, but are not limited to

- Supervise 1-2 projects – which require deep dives into subject matter for supporting learning and evaluation functions
- Able to create theory of change, M&E logframe, and associated requirements for rapid cycle evaluations as well as long term evaluation studies
- Create databases combining data from different sources and platforms
- Conduct data analysis of different program data, primary and secondary data
- Apply latest research theories to practice, apply innovative data collection and analysis methods
- Manage research partners and research agencies – through all phases of conceptualizing, designing a study to its eventual implementation, data collection and analysis
- Maintain relationships with partner institutions and research organizations
- Ensure quality of data during data collection and assisting with data cleaning
- Supervise data analysis, and questionnaire design
- Work with teams to understand data requirements and accordingly develop data-based solutions (for internal and external stakeholders)
- Draft documents (research summaries, briefs recommendations, vision documents) for external stakeholders

Required Qualifications, Skills and Abilities

- Master's Degree (or higher) in Education, Economics, Finance, Business, Development Studies, or related field is mandatory.
- Well-qualified Bachelor's candidates with significant related work experience will also be considered
- At least 4 to 8 years of evaluation and/or statistical analysis, experience in doing research in a national/international development context (or related fields) or in academic research settings
- Strong analytical skills with a good understanding of quantitative and qualitative research methods
- Experience in monitoring and evaluation, and/or participating in impact evaluation studies

- Demonstrated experience in data analysis, should have knowledge of different evaluation techniques
- Experience with statistical analysis packages such as R, Python, or Stata.
- Experience with data visualization, and in building dashboards
- Ability to lead meetings, deliver presentations
- Ability to work independently and proactively, without support staff and with little supervision
- Strong written and verbal communication skills
- Strong project management skills, and an ability to be able to set priorities, plan timelines and meet deadlines; can maintain an organized and structured work style in a fast-paced environment.
- Flexibility and ability to deal with uncertainty; adaptability to project needs and schedules
- Must be proficient in Gujarati and English

Desired Qualities

- Entrepreneurial spirit and ‘can-do’ attitude
- Operating style suited to working in a small-organization setting, where teamwork and resourcefulness are highly valued
- Excellent leadership skills, including ability to manage multiple activities at a time
